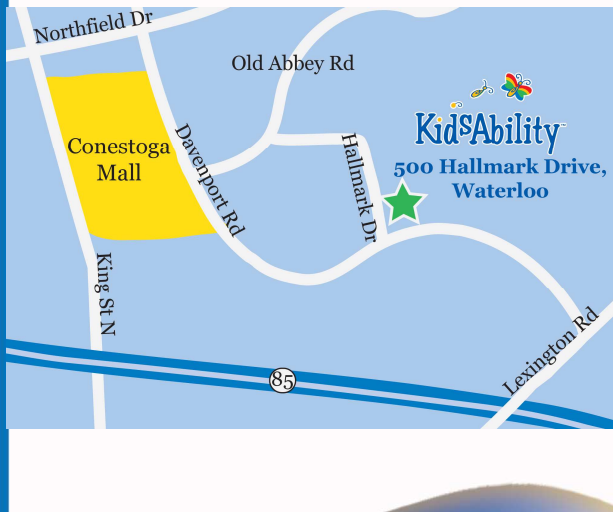

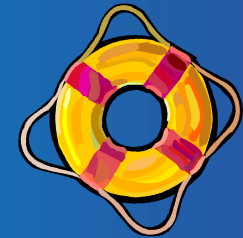

Swimming Lessons



Firefly Therapy Services swimming program provides an opportunity for children to learn important basic swimming skills in a safe and supportive environment. Our accessible pool is a welcoming place to practice and grow confident in new abilities. The instructors are patient, knowledgeable, and have experience working with a wide range of needs.

This program was designed as an alternative to swimming lessons in a traditional setting. It is intended to be sensory-friendly and individualized. We use a wide range of strategies to develop skills in a positive, fun setting. Skilled volunteers are used to assist in the smooth implementation of the program.

Goals:

The goals/skills that may be targeted include (but are not limited to):

- Water Safety
- Entries & Exits
- Breath Control
- Floats
- Front Glide/Back Glide
- Underwater Skills

When?

- Program cycles (8 weekly sessions) are offered in the Winter, Spring, and Fall.
- All sessions are held afterschool hours.

\$120 (per cycle)

Who will benefit?

- Children who require extra support with their swimming skills, or who are having difficulties in traditional swimming lesson settings.
- Children who do not have significant language delays*.
- Children who are able to attend and engage in an activity for 5-10 minutes without redirection.
- Children who do not exhibit disruptive/aggressive behaviour.

We recognize that children at this swim level may have slightly different abilities—the low ratio of children to adults will enable the instructor to modify and individualize goals so that each child benefits from this group.
