BE A CONVENOR!

Being a convenor is a great way to help the Club run a successful program. Convenors are the link between Club administrators and each age division. Convenors serve as a voice between division players, parents and coaches, and office staff. This position is vital to the success of the Club. Please notify the office if you are interested in offering your services!

“I’ve Registered.....Now What??”

All coaches will receive their team roster at one of our coaches clinic held in late April. (see “Become a Coach” section). Coaches are advised to call all players from their roster at least one week before the start of programming. If you do not receive a call from your son/daughter’s coach by **May 5th (Learn To Train & Soccer For Life programs) or May 12th (Active Start & FUNdamentals)**, please contact the Club after these dates.

Your coach will confirm the date, time and field location where you are to meet for your first scheduled game/practice. Upon meeting your coach, you will receive a uniform (jersey, socks, shorts) and a soccer ball.

During the first phone conversation with your new coach, please collect and record all necessary contact information. Write down the team name, coach’s name and coach’s e-mail address or phone number. This will be very important for future interaction.

Remember: sessions scheduled on holidays will still be played!

WHEN TO REGISTER (4 OPTIONS):

OPTION 1: Pre-Registration

For interested conveners, coaches and their children ONLY: Monday, January 27th - Friday, January 31st during regular business hours.

OPTION 2: Online Registration

Available at 10:00am on Saturday, February 1st, 2014

OPTION 3: Mass Registration

Saturday, February 1st, 2014- 10:00 am - 2:00pm
Sunday, February 2nd, 2014 - 10:00am - 2:00pm

OPTION 4: Regular Registration

Continues Monday, February 3rd, 2014 during normal business hours for all programs that do not fill during mass registration.

Registration is based on capacity and will close as divisions fill

PAYMENT OPTIONS

REFUND POLICY

To request a refund, a Refund Request Form must be submitted to the KSC office. All refunds will be subject to a \$20.00 administration fee.

- Refunds will be granted prior to April 30th
- 50% Refund will be granted starting May 1st
- NO REFUNDS** will be granted after the start of the season.

FAMILY DISCOUNT

Families registering three (3) or more children will receive a \$20.00 discount per sibling.
