Simple Solutions Math – <http://www.simplesolutions.org/> - Begins in Kindergarten. The continuous review and practice enables many students to complete Algebra I by the end of eighth grade.

Math 24 – <http://www.24game.com/> - The 24 game is a unique mathematics teaching tool that has proven to successfully engage students in grades 1 through 9.

Turbo Math – http://www.nordicsoftware.com/web/product_index/turbo_math_facts Software used to provide practice in basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. As children answer problems, they earn money to buy race cars for an interactive race. Tutorial help available through 'pit-stops" when children miss problems. Tracks individual progress and prints worksheets.

FastT Math – <http://www.tomsnyder.com/fasttmath/index.html> This intervention program helps struggling students develop fluency with basic math facts in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Provides a continuously adaptive program that efficiently increases math fact fluency in customized, 10-minute lessons.

Do the Math – Scholastic – <http://teacher.scholastic.com/products/dothemath/> Organized into 13 scaffolded modules that focus on rebuilding fluency with whole numbers and fluency with fractions. Every module includes a series of thirty 30-minute step-by-step lessons. Focusing on Number and Operations, the cornerstone of elementary mathematics, the program teaches students the basics of math—computation, number sense, and problem solving. Do The Math helps students develop the skills they need to compute with accuracy and efficiency, the number sense they need to reason, and the ability to apply their skills and reasoning to solve problems.
