DISCUSSION

- Funfair Raffle funds will fund outdoor play equipment fundraising use has been submitted
- · Rheo Thompson fundraiser ongoing
 - Will wait to see the total funds raised before deciding how to allocate the funds
- · Council can revisit funding requests in January meeting

6. CURIOSITY CONVENTION

DISCUSSION

- · No update since last meeting
- · Staff are keen, questions about how to run it, should it be in the evening
 - Council is in favour of an evening event along, projects would be also displayed the following day for students to see
- · Will be announced after Winter break, to be held in February or March

7. MISCELLANEOUS

DISCUSSION

- · Frequency of screen time in classrooms discussed
 - o There are no board guidelines, up to teacher discretion
 - Is it possible for parents to be given more concrete information about how much they are using screens on a regular basis, in order for parents to better monitor child's total screen time
 - ACTION: Phillip to bring up with teachers
- ACTION: Phillip to look into bouncy band
- Caitlin reached out to Sparks Fly to try to connect with a program rep, has not heard back ACTION: Caitlin will follow up to try to get someone to talk to council about the program

PROPOSAL

SPRING SCHOOL PLAY - proposed by Caitlin (not to replace Arts Concert)

- Would need 1 or more staff volunteers
- Open to grades 1-6
- 2 performances: 1 matinee + 1 evening
- Looking for a play with a flexible cast, wide appeal, approx. 45 min run time
- Play not finalized yet still open to council/teacher input and ideas
- Production assistant roles offered to older students, students to be involved in all aspects putting on a production
- · Main roles can be divided
- Aiming to announce the play in January, will hold student info meeting in January to gauge student (and parent) interest before script is finalized.
- · Auditions (for main speaking roles), final script, and casting in February
- Play will ramp up after the Curiosity convention has wrapped up, and will finish well before the Funfair

- Schedule TBD will be based on the day 1-5 schedule, Rehearsals will be mostly at breaks, with some afterschool rehearsals, Day 2 and 5 first break in the gym is already booked
- Parents will be given a mailer, prior to auditions, outlining the requirements of participation. Main cast members will need to be able to attend certain afterschool rehearsals
- Some fundraising will be necessary Should popcorn sales go toward the play? Do we ask a small participation fee to cover basic budget?
- Initial budget ask was \$575, would be able to do more if more funds are raised
- No decision about funding play to be made until the new year School to cover cost of script and rights \$100, pending final decision
- ACTION: Caitlin to connect with Andrea Hill re: mailer and info meeting
