PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

DISCUSSION

- Mrs Dicsi has had to leave early for her maternity leave and a supply teacher will be in the classroom for two weeks, Phillip will be hiring a teacher for the remainder of the school year
- 260 students are registered for the next year. Kindie numbers are lower this year but are anticipated to increase.
- Staffing for 2019-2020 school year will be 3 full Kindie classes, 3 Grade ½ splits, 2 straight Grade 3 classes, 2 split 4/5 classes, and 2 split 5/6 classes
- Assignments have been given to teachers and a voluntary transfer can occur if they want to change their class assignment
- The goal is to have staffing in order by June for September.
- Meadowlane will be 50 next year so we can start the conversation about a celebration. Think about some ideas for the celebration and we can discuss at the next meeting
- Would Council be interested in working with the Councils from John Darling and Sandhills to see if we are interested in having parents get together from the three schools for an evening of learning during the next school year? Alyssa will be the Liaison with the other two councils.
