Talked to Lexia Pilot program – showed us a slide show to show us how it supports the children and the staff

Computer program that aims to build the foundational reading skills for students

Science or 6 pillars of reading – phonological awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and structural analysis

Students get certificates based on their achievement

Helps teachers with the tools for a wide range of student's levels

Students are given a placement test when they first start to ensure they are started at the right level for their success

Went through examples of what the students learn – the scope and sequence

Showed difference between kindergarten to grade 5 and how the lessons change

Teachers are seeing great growth from the beginning in October till now – students are referring things to learning it in Lexia

Because it's a pilot project, teachers have been reporting back – the board is then looking at results to see if it's a good program to keep at Meadowlane and also introduce to other schools

Dreambox is another program/tool that is used for mathematical learning

Online learning platform like lexia, with over 2000 math lessons – aligned with our math curriculum – understanding number sense and problem solving

It adapts to the students learning no matter what level they are at

Students are assigned their grade level and or can be changed on the their level of knowledge

Performance is sent to teachers so teachers know where they are at and if intervention need to take place

60-90 minutes a week to support their learning

Teachers can see all lessons covered and students milestone – can see where they are doing great or having trouble

Teachers can assign lessons to students – as well as quizzes or assessments – students think they are just fun math games but it's giving teachers a look at where student is
