1. Treasurer's Report

• Breakdown of sales shown in account provided:

Popcorn sales: \$1238 (cumulative total from Oct 17 to Jan 8)

2. Principal's Report

• School Improvement Plan - Right to Read

The main focus of the school this year is reading, and school is shifting to a new way of teaching reading to students.

Continuing to use Lexxia through out all Gr 2- 6 grades. Haggerty and Ufly are being used in JK & SK. Power- Up also being used with Gr 6's.

Marc shared Framework by grades to show how data is compiled and used by staff.

- Staff learning how to data and work on next steps for students to move along in reading. Lexxia was launched in October and already seeing results. Positive results! Other pilot schools in board are using Meadowlane's data to see how it works. Marc to make a point of sharing progress of grades at each meeting.

• PRO GRANT – (Parents Reaching Out Grant?)

Board is doing things a little differently this year- giving each school \$500 rather than applying for grant. Ideally used to support school improvement plan – for Meadowlane, it's Reading. Examples from the board on what grant can be used for:

- to purchase books and/or videos that can be leant to parents
- Guest presenters
- Orientations

Council asked to think about what to do grant

- possibly revisit guest speaker idea from previous years
- Ms Williams and Regulation? Is using Zones of Regulation but slowly shifting from this and looking into a new program to use.
