Minutes for Millen Woods Public School Parent Council Meeting November 15, 2017

Administration Report (Trish)

- EQAO results were reviewed, a package was provided for discussion purposes. A
 reminder that this is one piece of data tested over 4 days, and other data is also used for
 evaluation purposes. This package is available to parents upon request at the office
 - The school is able to drill down into the data provided in many ways, which enables the school to identify to the student level those who are struggling, and provide help and next steps to those students.
 - Overall, Millen Woods does well on the results compared to the board level and province level results
 - The data can also be sorted for trends, the school can review how students performed 4 years ago in Grade 3, and how those exact students performed in Grade 6 (making for an apples to apples comparison on that group of children). Looking through this data
 - 83% of the children met the standards for reading, 83% writing, 64% mathematics
 - In both reading and writing, there was a trend of improvement in percentages those who didn't meet the standard in grade 3 did meet it in grade 6. In Mathematics, it was the opposite
 - we are seeing a gap at the grade 3 level of males in all 3 areas compared to females in the past few years
 - Millen Woods will continue to focus on mathematics improvements. To that end:
 - Trish would like to hold a math night for the students to show the parents what they are doing in math, and how strategies have changed
 - Kristin Philips from the board does a TED talk in math that Trish recommends
 - Stephanie Ringwood is coming back in to review how math is taught in Mme Cadieux's class
 - French math teachers are coming together to make sure that we are using common language in all the grades/classes, and stacking the learning between the teachers/grades appropriately
 - looking at the tech club and coding as a method of encouraging math
 - EQAO is also reviewing the way in which they do the testing in the future (perhaps more electronic and interactive)
 - Rozy asked how many opted out of the EQAO testing 4 opted out in grade 3, 6 opted out in grade 6.

- question by Andrea if there was data available on mathematics statistics French immersion vs. English (not part of the report, but the school can drill in the data and review)
- Renee asked if there was data on transitioning grade 6s from having math in French to grades 7s having it in English. Trish responded that the board made that decision based on results it had seen on decreased math scores in French immersion students compared to English between grades 7 and 9. It is a fairly recent switch
- The school received data from the safe/inclusive schools survey, and will be reviewing as a staff
 - At this time, we've not had any children answer that they've cyber bullied anyone, or ever been cyber bullied
 - Compass crew working on bullying awareness week next week,
 - Monday Scott Graham is coming in for a 45 minute presentation with the junior grades, then with the senior grades (he'll discuss useful strategies to deal with bullying); we need to discuss what different types of bullying are, and discuss it now so it can be carried forward as our children grow
 - wear pink day is coming up, details to follow
 - Sarah Westbrook will be coming in Feb to speak on bullying, and will offer a parents session as well
- The week of giving is coming in December (Munchkin Monday, Toiletry Tuesday, Wooly Wednesday, Toy Thursday, Food bank Friday)

Tech club (Trish)

- Mme Daniels, Ms Chapelle, Mr Bezos, Ms Webber have someone come in to discuss coding (Google offers workshops for teachers in Scratch)
 - Rob Daily (ex principal) creating their own games using coding, and then trying out each others games. He'll come in 4 times this year (grade 4/5)
 - Tech club (grades 4/5/6) created a slide show of Spheros in action, to be reviewed

- Cover letter contents and timing discussed we will raise money for Breakfast for Learning at Wilson Ave P. S. and the playground (voted and approved)
