- Walk to School – May 9<sup>th</sup> is the next big Walk to School day, Colleen Cooper has offered to help develop walking school buses for the school and they are still working on a date for initial meeting, Stay tuned
- Bullying prevention – LIT assembly to stand up for bullying, was a big success, they video taped and showed the school their bullying skits, next project is Earth Day, presentations to be presented at school assembly

## 2. Council Matters

### Financials – Jenna

- Jenna and Sunni met with Michelle to resolve some issues
  - June 2017 \$5500 left-over in account for beginning of this school year
  - \$26,500 for pizza collected, profit approx. \$10,000 once all calculated in the end
  - Slightly < \$700 for ESNS, \$6700 Move a thon profit, \$79 Mabels/Labels, \$290 Used book sale
  - \$3500 character development and chrome book
  - Nothing paid out for gym equipment and scooter racks as of yet, difficulty sourcing lockable scooter racks as the Canadian company is no longer around
  - Reserve fund – to be discussed in the next meeting, to go on the agenda
  - The used book sale funds do not go into school council funds but to the school itself for home reading
  - Used book sale amount of \$217.20 is an expenditure not a revenue – to be adjusted
  - ESNS –viability for next year to be discussed, Pita only returning could also be an option
  - 15 % restriction on the total revenue ‘rule’ to be discussed at next meeting, difficult to plan around when amount is unknown until the end of the year
