21. Welcome/ previous Meeting minutes: Magdi moves to approve minutes from previous meeting (October 11th,2023) Reza seconds. Motion passes unanimously.
22. Marcus' welcome: -Thanks everyone for coming on virtually on such short notice.
23. Nutrition for Learning update: - Francine addressed whether $\$ 300$ is adequate to sponsor a school's NFL onboarding. Her NFL contact indicated that $\$ 300$ is far below the threshold and, regardless, NFL is currently at capacity and can't support additional area schools.

- While NFL cannot handle additional schools, donations to NFL are greatly appreciated.


## 4. Principal's Update :

- Provided quotes for some requested items:

White boards for classrooms-\$1000.00
DPA bags - $\$ 1500.00$
French games - \$500.00
Letter tiles- \$500.00
KW symphony school tour- $\$ 375.00$
Gaga ball pit and tarmac paint- $\$ 3000.00$ (estimated - still TBD)
Basketball nets for younger area - TBD

- Sarah inquires about if we still want to purchase french home reading books. It was a budget item from last year's council. Marcus says some schools are shifting away from french Home reading. This is under review at the moment.
- Jenna asks about the budget, and whether we can afford all wish-list items Sarah responds that we are in good shape.
- Bill moves that counsel approve purchasing the wishlist items with actual costs attached, including White boards, DPA bags, French games, Letter tiles and the Symphony Tour. Pooja seconds. All in favour. Motion passes.
- Jenna moves to allocate $\$ 3000.00$ to tarmac and Gaga ball pit. Pooja seconds. It was noted, and the motion amended to indicate, that Marcus will inform the council of actual costs before moving forward with these purchases. All in favour. Motion passes.
- Pooja inquires whether we should start putting money aside for future big projects. Table this conversation for now.
- Marcus has been looking into getting speakers in to talk about online dangers. Has spoken to a phycologist of the school board for details on who we could get. Ongoing project. More of an update next meeting.
- Year end for Grade 6's. Marcus brought it up with our family of schools (10 schools in this area). Spoke with other Admins. As a group they plan to ask the superintendent about how to make a potential overnight trip happen. Have not heard back yet but expect to hear back soon.
- EQAO results. www.eqoa.com/reports. Marcus reviewed our results with council. - Bill raised concern re the drop in all areas, and particularly in math, from last year. Marcus indicated that some fluctuation is expected among different cohorts from year to year, He also noted a big focus on reading last year, though reading/writing scores also dropped from last year. Educators are working hard to find a good balance. Reza- suggests we try to learn from high performing schools in the area. Marcus noted it is not an easy doable task, and assures that MJ is always trying to improve and learning how to do the job better. Marcus mentions he was also interested in the questionnaire the students were asked to fill out. How do they feel about school. Confidence levels and eagerness to learn. It is important to look at those items also. Leah- Overall MJ is doing well.

A few percentages up or down seems reasonable. Amy Y- Reviewing the numbers, we are in good shape and feels like teachers do a great job at MJ. We are above average for the province and in this area. Bill- just because students say they are "happy in math class", it isn't a success if the kids don't know math. Happiness is of course important, but kids are at school to learn.
5. Finance review: - Even after all the wishlist spending we have significant funds remaining. All expected costs at this point are equal to our expected income for the year, leaving significant remaining funds.

- Pooja mentions the expectation is to spend the money we raise or have it earmarked for a big project.
- Marcus will review any big ticketed items we might need for the next 5 years.
- Janice reminds us about the outdoor learning space idea. Would be nice to have this for the community and our students.

6. Council Matters: - Pizza: Allanna is gathering volunteers. There will be 2 additional payment instalments for pizza this year.

- Coat Drive: Pooja will work on a date with Marcus and get the ball rolling.
- Spirit Wear - could we have an alternate logo? Just an MJ?
- Leah and Janice to discuss
- Items we are considering: t-shirts (short and long, red and black), track pants (black) hoodies (red and black) toques (black and grey)
- Timing - 14th or 15 th until 26 th ( $1.5-2$ weeks) - then 4 weeks until the holidays, ideally get there in time! If we firm things up today we can confirm timelines with vendor
- Leah will see if we can get sample sizes - will connect with Marcus about whether that is an option
- Janice suggested we put them up in a window for parents to view

Administrator

- Marcus to let the kindergarten teachers know that they can spend the \$65

- Bill indicated that while ideally fundraising would be run through School Counsel, he does not think Counsel has the ability, or the right, to tell classes what they can and can't do.
- Perhaps there is a need for each class to have a budget for classroom resources
- Marcus to take away this away
- Sarah to send out an email about Mabel's Labels'
