- But kids are savvy and they find things that are not on the approved list

- Magdi motioned to give \$1000, Sarah seconded. Vote passed.

Financial Review (Sarah)

- We had approved an extra $\$ 100$ per class for this year
- From an accounting perspective, we will need to spend that $\sim \$ 1800$ next year instead
- Total including the WEFI is a balance of $\$ 58,419$
- Current expenses will come to under \$10K
- $\$ 17,000$ came in and $\$ 5,000$ has gone out for Gino's pizza so far
- We should end the year with $\sim \$ 47,000$; we opened the year with $\sim \$ 48,000$
- Pizza is the only fundraiser that we really have
- There is a new facility supervisor/manager who has been here twice this year and they are coming back and want to discuss the outdoor learning space; we need to determine what we want first and then determine how much funding we need
- We had voted on two trees in the past but we need to go through a grounds crew; maybe we can ask the city to do it for free

We'll skip pizza this meeting.
Pooja

- Asked for \$600 grant for a math night which we'll use to purchase activities / book / etc.

Marcus

- Grade 6 teachers have a two-night overnight camp and a one day excursion camp; $2 / 3$ of the grade 6 caregivers submitted a response and it was almost $50 / 50$ on which option they prefer; next step is to gauge some next moves
- Grade 6 celebration: last day of school they will clap out, balloon canopies, cake, fruit, photo opp; Monday June 24th or Tuesday June 25th would invite caregivers in, titled "bring an adult" with a food choice, games like capture the flag
- Can arrange something at UB1 or UB2 for the grade $6 s$ - in the past, grade 6 parents have done it, but this is not organized by Council

- Get each class involved with music selection

- We talked to Mme Daly to have buddies from that less fortunate school and do visits back and forth to experience community, playground, campus, etc.
