



TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT UPDATE

BACKGROUND

The Region of Waterloo is planning the reconstruction of Myers Road in 2020. In April's public consultation, members of the Moffat Creek Public School community expressed significant concerns about traffic around the school. The Region's preferred design concept would eliminate areas which are currently being used by parents to park at arrival and dismissal times.

STATUS

The Waterloo Region District School Board (Board), Region of Waterloo and City of Cambridge are working together to develop a solution that addresses student safety.

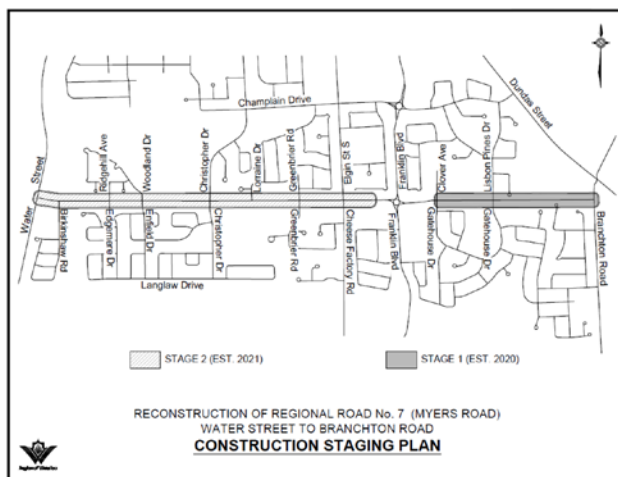
The Board has set a budget to develop a preferred solution. The solution will look at the following:

- Student and pedestrian safety
- Traffic flow at arrival and dismissal times
- Bus parking
- School parking
- Child care parking

NEXT STEPS

Board staff will work over the summer to complete detailed designs that address the traffic safety issues. Solutions may include alternatives to creating more parking on the school site.

The Board hopes to share this solution with to you in the fall of 2019.
