Planning for our annual year-end visit to Camp Wabanaki is well underway, and as always, the trip should prove to be a wonderful and memorable experience for Margaret Avenue's Grade 8 students!

Attendance at this event is considered to be a privilege. Students must earn the privilege of attending Camp Wabanaki by demonstrating appropriate behaviour and respect for peers and staff throughout the school year.

Given the distant location, time away from home, and nature of activities associated with this trip (e.g., swimming, canoeing, archery, mountain-biking), students planning to attend must prove they are responsible and trustworthy. Students who have shown that they are defiant or cannot follow instructions pose a safety threat to themselves and others. School suspensions, non-compliance to rules, self-harming, and refusal to complete schoolwork are also behaviours that may prohibit a student from attending camp.

In consideration of the safety and well-being of all students participating in this activity and staff that will be supervising, the administration of Margaret Avenue School (in conjunction with input from the teaching staff) will make the final decision as to which students are eligible to attend this event. Alternative programs or day trips will be offered for those students who do not attend the Camp Wabanaki Field Trip.
