2. Welcome / Territory Acknowledgment:

As we gather virtually this evening would like to honor the existence of the 1st peoples by acknowledging that we are on the traditional land of the Anishinaabe, Haudenosaunee and Mississauga peoples and New Dundee Public School occupies the land of the between the lakes treaty from 1792. As learners we continue to understand this place has significance to the 1st peoples because of the rolling hills, forests, flat land, along with the proximity to the Nith and Grand River that is fed by the Great Lakes. Settlers need to take responsibility to continue our education and honour of the first peoples. 2. Principal's Report:

with the school until the end of February.

- C. Assemblies: Mr Grundy along with some staff and students have been preparing for the Safe, Caring and Inclusive School Community plan. There will be an assembly in the coming weeks.
- D. Clubs/ Field Trips/ Events: Staff have offered some Intramurals for the students in blocks for grades. - e. Poinsettia update (Jess): \$458.00 raised for the school. Jess feels that this is a very simple fundraiser with a great ROI for the school. She is happy to continue this again next year.
- f. Dundee Dragon Art: Mr Grundy, Ms De Naeyer, are the staff leading the Safe, Caring and Inclusive School Community plan. A community member has volunteered to donate some vinyl to support the vision of the school environment and messaging. Angie will send an email with an introduction between the community member and the staff leading the project.

All primary schools in Wilmot are collaborating on bringing in a speaker(s) on the topics outlined in the grant application. The grant application was submitted to the PIC committee.

We wanted to make it inclusive for all so we reduced the amount of items to be sold, so there will be mint smoothies, a 1/2 lbs box of the small mint smoothies, a five inch chocolate bunny and a bunny head sucker. and we can processes and report back at the next meeting.(Steph B moved, Jess D second)
