## 1. Terry Fox Run - Sept. 27th, 2013

- Toonies for Terry were collected before the run (Total raised = \$511.59)
- assembly in the morning followed by the walk/run
- apples and pledge stickers (I'm running for...) distributed to classes after the run

2. TLC DANCES for Gr. 7/8-Oct. 17th, 2012 \& Feb. 2oth, 2013 (tentative)
$\cdot$ profits from both dances will support FTC initiatives

- $\$ 4$ entrance ( $\$ 3$ with canned food item in October for our We Scare Hunger campaign)
- food/drinks may be sold for $\$ 1$ a can or bag

3. WE SCARE HUNGER - Hallowe'en Food Drive - Oct. 22nd to Oct. 26th - a food drive and Pumpkin Shoot (or similar activity to be determined) will take place

- classes will bring in canned food and will have a chance to win more tickets at the Pumpkin Shoot (Primary, Junior \& Intermediate pumpkin prize winners will be drawn)
- TLC members will also take wagons out to collect canned food on Hallowe'en night

## 4. December Campaign

a) WE CREATE CHANGE - Canada's Largest Penny Drive

- collection bags will be provided by Free the Children
- students collect pennies and fill bags up to the red line
- bags are returned to school for delivery to a local RBC branch
- donations will help to provide clean water programs for FTC's Adopt a Village communities overseas

- profits will go to our clean water campaign
