What marks do Universities look at?

Universities make conditional offers for acceptance into university based on: **Final Semester 1 marks and April midterm marks** (plus any final marks of 4U/4M courses the student took in Grade 11 or at summer school)

In October, PHS Guidance sends OUAC (the Ontario University Application Center) a *Demographics Extract* to highlight which PHS students have a plan of completing enough 4U/M courses by the end of June, to be able to apply to university.

In this extract, the PHS student's grade 11 marks are included. Grade 11 marks are used by universities to make Round 1, Early Acceptance offers for high achieving students. The universities continue to make several Rounds of Offers from October through until May.

The majority of offers are made AFTER all applications are submitted on the due date in January.

All university-bound students will need to make a decision by June 1, about which program they are accepting.
