You will need a PIN to apply (pick up in guidance) ▪ Recommendation: Apply by the end of Christmas break to be ahead of the due date <p>Due Date: 2nd week of January typically</p>
To how many programs can I apply?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Five program choices for a cost of \$95; Extra program choices cannot be added ▪ A Maximum of three program choices at any one college 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Three programs for \$150; plus \$50 for every extra program choice added ▪ Maximum of three program choices at any one university
