

First thoughts

This is *a time consuming process* so prepare to dive in and research, plan and act in order to accomplish your goal of achieving some form of financial aid. You find scholarships they don't find you, and keep in mind you never win scholarships you don't apply for! Begin by creating a folder (both digital and paper). This should include all reference letters, applications, essays and forms completed. This is useful going forward with your search and you can reuse suitable material for future applications.

Check timelines carefully! Scholarship applications run throughout the school year and many happen each month. Have a monthly target you plan to apply for and be sure to meet your timelines. Note: If you require a school endorsement for your award or scholarship you must submit this request to guidance a minimum 2 weeks prior to the final due date.



 SPECIFIC UNIVERSITY and/or COLLEGE WEBSITES DIRECTLY Google the School Name and type in "Financial Aid" to find possible scholarships for students entering first year. Create the following:

- Activity List of your past involvements at school, work or community.
- A personal strengths list of your positive qualities and attributes.
- A list of potential references.
- A scholarship calendar.

Clean up your social media accounts.

Read all scholarships carefully for key words and bios of previous winners.

Scholarship Committees are Looking for:

- 1) Valuable work experience and qualities gained from this employment opportunity.
- 2) How you have overcome obstacles in the past.
- 3) School involvements in any capacity.
- 4) Volunteer work how these have shown your passions and personality.
- 5) Unique traits you possess. What makes you you.
- 6) Examples of leadership, initiative and innovation.

Know your audience and share information that provides depth and personality.

Proofread carefully and be aware of due dates!

Be patient and determined as you seek financial aid. Entrance scholarships for your marks are always a good starting point, and OSAP is tried and true when looking for aid that everyone is eligible to apply for.
