Types of Courses:

Grades 9 and 10: **D** = Academic **P** = Applied (Gr 10) **O** = Open **W**= Destreamed

Grades 11 and 12: **U** = University **M** (**U/C**) = University/ College **C** = College **E** = Workplace **O** = Open

Number of courses required per grade:

Students must complete 30 courses (18 compulsory and 12 elective) in order to graduate.

The number of courses required for Grade 9 and Grade 10 is EIGHT (8).

The number of courses required for Grade 11 and 12 is a minimum of SIX (6).*

*Students are required to maintain full time status (3 courses per semester) throughout the school year.
