



HERE'S HOW YOU APPLY :

- ❑ The OUAC portal opens in September www.ouac.on.ca
- ❑ Find your OEN Number on your graduation summary, report card
- ❑ Use your personal email address; school accounts close June 2024
- ❑ Choices don't get sent to universities until you click submit and pay
- ❑ **\$156** fee for initial three program choices
- ❑ **\$50** fee for each additional program choice
- ❑ Application deadline: **January 15, 2024** (apply during Dec. break)
- ❑ Read all emails from universities after you apply for next steps or look for Messages on "My Undergraduate Hub" in OUAC
- ❑ Check the OUAC portal for offers or refusals and respond by selecting "Accept" when you have made a firm decision

MARKS SENT TO OUAC:

- ❑ September - Demographic Submission - Grade 11 marks
 - ❑ November - Semester 1 grade 12 Midterm Marks
 - ❑ February - Semester 1 grade 12 Final Marks
 - ❑ April - Semester 2 grade 12 Midterm Marks
 - ❑ July - Semester 2 grade 12 Final Marks
 - ❑ August - Summer School Marks
-
- ❑ All offers of admission are conditional upon receiving final marks

IMPORTANT DATES FOR UNIVERSITY:

You apply by:

- ❑ **January 15, 2024** - application is due for equal consideration

Universities must make offers by:

- ❑ **May 29, 2024**- Notification of decision (all offers are conditional)
- ❑ **June 3, 2024** - date you may be required to respond to an offer and give a financial commitment

EARLY ACCEPTANCE TO UNIVERSITY:

Some students get caught up about EARLY ACCEPTANCE from University

- ❑ You cannot apply for early acceptance - universities find you based on your Gr 11 marks.
- ❑ If you are given early acceptance, you still have to maintain your average, and, once at university, there is no difference between you and students admitted at the regular time.

RESEARCHING

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR ONTARIO UNIVERSITIES:

- ❑ 6 Gr 12 U/M courses - check individual programs for pre-requisite courses
- ❑ Program Specific Requirements can include:
 - ❑ Portfolio, auditions, tests such as CASPer
 - ❑ Supplemental Information Form


CHECK DEADLINES!

QUESTIONS TO ASK YOURSELF TO NARROW WHERE TO APPLY:

- Is the program I want to take, unique to only a few universities?
- Do I want to live at home while I attend university?
- Am I willing to live in a city without family nearby?
- Do I have a family member that I could live with in a different city, while attending university?
- Would I choose to go to the same university as an older sibling?
- How large of a city would I want to live in?
- Do I want to live close enough to have the ability to come home regularly on weekends?

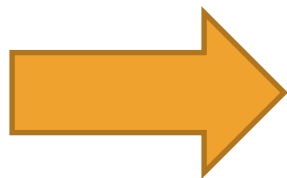
