## Teacher/Principal Updates - Marc

#### Staffing:

Amanda Cross will be returning after March Break. We are grateful to have had Rebecca Haddaway in the interim occasional position.

Leah Klassen will be off on maternity leave after March Break. We are currently in the process of hiring for that vacancy.

From the latest conversation with our superintendent, it is looking likely that Marc will finish the year as interim principal.

We are lucky to have some elementary supervision monitors to help out during nutrition breaks to supervise in kindergarten and other areas of the school.

The board and school have a need for emergency staff. These are people who do not have qualifications as an educator but the school can still use them to help in limited ways around the school. We are able to put our 4 supervision monitors on this emergency list for when we are short on staff.

### • Academics:

We are now into our second academic term.

Everyone is encouraged to visit the WRDSB <u>Structured Literacy Multi-Year Plan</u> link on the public site. Structured Literacy aligns with the Board Improvement and Equity Plan. As a result of the <u>Ontario Human Rights Commission's Right To Read Report</u>, literacy was deemed a fundamental human right. The Board's Structured Literacy is a response to the findings in the report and outlines a very clear programming structure and supports to meet the needs of all students. The multi-year scaffolding of language of literacy skills moves from *word recognition* to *fluency and language comprehension* and concludes with *skilled reading*.

The WRDSB has also released its <u>Math Achievement Action Plan</u> this week which you are encouraged to get familiar with.

#### Facilities:

As a result of regular use of the Gaga Ball pit, a work order has been submitted to bring in some wood chips or EWF (Engineered Wood Fibre) to resurface the play area. We

- are also looking into topping up the enclosed Kindergarten play area. Lindsay W. suggested to include the circumference of the outside of the Gaga Ball pit as well.
- GMP Sportswear web store is being created for our school spirit wear, with our new logos. Marc will share electronically with the council once he gets a link.
- PHL and STEM clubs are still running. Leadership Club with Grade 6s is a great opportunity for students to help out around the school. Students are currently auditioning for the school talent show, spearheaded by Mr. Peats-Bond and assisted by a group of other staff members. More information will follow once we have some dates and times for the show.
