

Traffic Flow at Sir Adam Beck Public School

A Entry and Exit to Parking Lot: Please note the new turning lanes and be very careful at this entry as we will have pedestrian, bus and other vehicle movement at this location. We will have staff supervision at this location to assist pedestrians beginning at 8:05 every morning. Once you enter the parking lot we ask you to move around the parking spaces as indicated by the arrows → on the map.

B Kiss and Drop Area: If it is necessary for you to drive your child to school we ask you to either park your car in a designated available parking space or pull along the curb in this area. This is not a parking area, but rather a location designed so that your child can safely exit your vehicle and proceed into the playground by going around to the back of the school. → Students should not walk around the front of the school in the morning.


C Handicapped and Visitor Parking: These spaces will be kept open for parents and other people visiting our school. Please proceed around the parking lot to arrive at these spots rather than cutting across the entrance.



D Bus Lane: The lane in front of the school is reserved for bus movement and parking and should not be used as an entry or exit route to and from the school during regular school hours. At the beginning





and end of each day the school busses for our school will and use this area to safely transfer your child. As in the past, all students, including those in Kindergarten will exit their bus at the far end of the school. Kindergarten students will exit first with the assistance of bus patrols and waiting staff so that the bus patrols can walk with them to the area behind the school, [G \(Safe Zone and Marked Tarmac\)](#) , and then enter the building using the door closest to their rooms.

It is important to note that parents picking up their Kindergarten child at the end of the day will now do so at this back door and not at the front entry door.

The remaining students on the bus will then exit and enter the playground as indicated. 

E Entry for Walking or Riding Students: In order to provide for a safe entry and exit to our school playground we are asking that any student walking or riding their bicycle to and from school please follow the route indicated on the map  that takes them along the sidewalk across the front of the school, crosses the Bus Lane in front of the busses where the driver can see them, and onto the playground along the path provided. 

Students will be required to walk their bicycle across the Bus Lane and to the bicycle racks provided. Please remember that all of our bicycle riders should have a helmet and be prepared to lock their bicycle.

F Tarmac Meeting Area: It is important to note that there will not be a staff member on supervision duty until 8:05 a.m. each day. Students arriving prior to this time will not be supervised and it is therefore not appropriate for them to be here. Bus students will not be allowed off of their bus until a teacher has arrived for duty. Because there is very little time before our 8:20 entry bell, students will be asked to remain on the tarmac and will form class lines to enter the building using doors as indicated.  If you are at the school waiting to pick up your child at the end of the day, please wait for them in this area as they will be leaving the building using the side doors. The only students leaving the building using the front door  will be those in Kindergarten as they are walked out to their bus.

Parents picking up their Kindergarten child at the end of the day will do so at the back door and not at the front entry door.

G Kindergarten Safe Zone and Tarmac: As mentioned earlier, our Kindergarten students will be walked to this area in the morning by the bus patrols. If you need to drive your child to the school you are asked to park your vehicle and bring them around to this supervised area.

We thank you for your cooperation as we work together to keep every child safe and secure. In total we have approximately 435 students that require our best efforts to keep them safe, happy and healthy each and every day.

Our *Crowded* Parking Lot: As the school population increases and we open new classes and hire more staff, our parking lot spaces become more limited. We urge you to have students use bus transportation if provided or walk whenever possible. Parking on the grass and along the bus lanes is not to be a regular or daily practice.
