French Immersion Registration

This is a reminder that registration for the Grade 1 French Immersion program for the 2015 - 2016 school year began on Thursday, January 8th and will continue until Saturday, January 31st. Registrations received by January 31st will be used to create the Grade 1 classes for the French Immersion program for 2015-2016.

Interested families may register for the program at the Waterloo Region District School Board website: www.wrdsb.ca/french.

Students who register after January 31, 2015 will be placed in classes where space is available or be placed on a waiting list.

For the 2015-2016 school year, students will be placed in classes through the following process:

- Registrants who have a sibling registered in the French Immersion program will be given preference until Saturday, January 31, 2015.
- Registrants who live within the geographical boundary of the school, and have been registered prior to January 31, 2015, will be placed next. If the number of residential boundary
- registrants exceeds the number of spaces available in the program (20 per class), and all students with older siblings currently enrolled in the French Immersion program are placed, a lottery system will be used to determine acceptance into the program.
- If space is available, students registered by January 31, 2015 from out of boundary will be placed in the program via lottery.
- Any registrations received after January 31, 2015 will be placed in available classes or on waiting lists in the order they register, regardless of residency.
- Efforts will be made to accommodate as many waiting list students as possible.

A letter from the French Immersion school will be sent in March, 2015 to inform all families of children who registered for the program about the status of their enrollment.

Calling All 3 Year Olds



If you have a 3 year old at home who was born in 2011, this child is eligible to attend

Junior

Kindergarten at Sandhills Public School in September 2015.

If your child was born in 2010 and is **NOT** currently attending school, you may also register your child.

Registration will take place during the week of Monday February 2 to 6^{th} .

You are invited to the school to fill out the forms or you may visit the Sandhills website to download the Kindergarten Information Package and complete the forms at home.

You will need to provide your child's Proof of Birth such as a Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate, Statement of Live Birth or Canadian Passport.

If your child was born outside of Canada, you are required to bring one of following documents: Canadian Passport, Certificate of Canadian Citizenship, Confirmation of Permanent Residence, Certificate of Indian Status Card or Letter of Admission assigned by the WRDSB enrolment officer.

You will also need to provide a Proof of Address such as Lease/Rental agreement, Real Estate document, or Utility bill.
