Dear Parents/Guardians of Grade Nine Students:

Welcome to the 2016-2017 school year! This year all Grade 9 students will be receiving a Chromebook as part of the *Chromebook 1:1 Project* at all WRDSB Secondary Schools.

What is a Chromebook?

A Chromebook is a mobile computer that runs on Google's Chrome OS. These machines are designed to be used primarily while connected to the internet. They are optimized to allow the use of Google applications (ie: Google Drive, Calendar, Gmail and Google Classroom). WRDSB Students already have Google Apps accounts provided to them by the Board which they will use on their Chromebooks.

When will grade nine students be receiving their Chromebook?

We will be giving students their Chromebooks on the first day of school on September 6, 2016.

What forms will be required for students to receive their Chromebook?

Students will need to hand in their signed **Chromebook 1:1 Contract** in order to receive their device on the first day of school, September 6, 2016.

What type or model of Chromebook will grade nine students receive?

New Dell Chromebook 11 (Model Series: 3120 with the 180 degree hinge).

General Rules of Use

- Students and parents must complete and return the Chromebook 1:1 Contract before a Chromebook is issued.
- 2. **Chromebooks remain the property of WRDSB.** Please ensure the Chromebook and charging cord are always ready to be returned in good condition. Use of temporary identification stickers on the device is allowed and encouraged.
- 3. Students will receive a protective sleeve in their welcome package and are encouraged to use it to protect the Chromebook.
- 4. Students are welcome to decorate the outside of their Chromebook with temporary stickers. The identification information found on the bottom of the Chromebook should not be covered.
- 4. Please bring the Chromebook to school each day, fully charged.
- 5. Students are to keep boxes and take them home for recycling or storage.
- 6. Students will be able to take the Chromebooks home over holidays and summer. However, technical support will not be offered over this time.
- 7. Students are responsible for the care of the Chromebooks. Please report any damage or issues with your Chromebook immediately. Students may speak to any of your Teachers about any problems or concerns you may have regarding the use and care of the Chromebook.
- 8. In the event a Chromebook is lost, stolen, or intentionally damaged, the Students will meet with a Vice-Principal who will determine if there is cause for the student to pay (up to the full cost of a replacement currently \$330.00)
- Students would not be held responsible for a device that simply malfunctions (keyboard issues, battery no longer charging and etcetera).
