APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS THAT REQUIRE A SCHOOL NOMINATION

- 1. Download and complete a student résumé form
- 2. Submit your résumé to your Guidance Counsellor
- 3. Keep a copy for yourself on file

- 1. Begin your research early
- 2. Keep your information in one place
- 3. Pay attention to application due dates
- 4. Maintain your best marks and volunteer
- 5. Keep an eye on your Guidance Google Classroom

TIPS WHEN COMPLETING AN APPLICATION

- 1. Make sure that you meet the requirements before applying
- 2. Read and follow the instructions carefully
- 3. Have someone you trust help you
- Preparation is key don't wait until the last minute to complete your application





Bursaries

Bursaries are automatic grants of money provided to some students in need depending on specific situations.

- Complete the last page of the student resume
- Visit the websites provided and search for other bursary possibilities

Ontario Student Assistance Program

OSAP is a financial aid program that offers money through grants (money you don't have to pay back) and loans (money you repay once finished school).

The amount of money you can receive depends on your education expenses, course load, and personal financial situation.
