We are pleased to offer a Junior program again this year for students in grades 6, in addition to separate rooms for students in grades 7 and 8, grades 9 and 10, as well as grade 11 through to school leaving. Math Circles is not an instrument for fast-tracking students through the curriculum, but rather is seeking to foster interest in mathematics among talented students. The goal is more along the lines of expanding the mathematical horizons of the students, by introducing them to topics which are typically left outside the school curriculum.

We would like to invite a number of students from each school. Please advertise this to not only your very best students, but also to students who have indicated a real interest, although they may not have achieved up to their potential in the past. We hope that the participating students will take a serious interest in Math Circles, and we will expect them to attend classes, solve problems, and complete regular homework assignments.

Important Information


- All Math Circle students are required to register each year in order to attend. Registration will open on September 22nd, 2015 at ceme.uwaterloo.ca. The number of available spaces will be limited and those spaces will be filled on a first come, first served basis. There will still be no cost to attend Math Circles.
- The Grade 6 and the Grade 7/8 Math Circle rooms will again be offered on both Tuesday and Wednesday evenings each week. Tuesday night's presentations will be repeated on Wednesday night. Students wishing to join the Grade 6 or the Grade 7/8 room will be required to choose between attending on Tuesday night each week, or on Wednesday night each week. This selection will be made during the registration process.
- Meetings will take place on Tuesday (grade 6 and 7/8 only) and Wednesday evenings (all grades 6-12) from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. There will be 8 meetings in the fall and 8 meetings in the winter. The first fall meetings to be held on October 6/7, 2015 and the first winter meetings to be held on February 2/3, 2016.
- The meetings will be held at the University of Waterloo in the MC and the DC buildings. (Map included). The exact room numbers will be listed on the website at the end of September. As well, notices will be posted on October 6/7, 2015 in each building directing students to the appropriate rooms.
