## SKI AND SNOWBOARD CLUB INSTRUCTIONS

In order for our ski trip to be a safe and fun experience, there are some important instructions and rules that need to be followed:

- 1. Moonstone Ski Club and Stanley Park's Outdoor Club Staff reserve the right to remove you from the ski area (with no refund) if you exhibit unsafe practices on the hill (rough play, out-of-control skiing or snowboarding, etc.) that put others or yourself in danger.
- 2. You must sign in before leaving Stanley Park on the bus. Departure time and arrival time are on the letter.
- 3. Our meeting spot will be the Moonstone Cafeteria area. You must check in between 12:00 pm 12:15 pm at the meeting spot.
- 4. If you are renting equipment, it is your responsibility to return the equipment at least 15 minutes before you leave.
- 5. Tickets and final instructions will be delivered upon our arrival at the Meeting Spot.
- 6. Guest Services will assist you in trying to locate a teacher, if needed.
- 7. Teacher Supervision will take place both on the hill and in the Chalet. A teacher will be available at the Meeting Spot at all times
- 8. We are **checking out at 2:45 pm**, leaving **the meeting place** at 3:00 pm. Please have all your rental equipment back by 2:30 pm.
- 9. Take note that the School is not responsible for lost or stolen property! Please, lock up your personal items, skis or snowboards when not in use.

## 10. The partner system is a must during the outing session.

- 11. Bring your lunch or money to buy food.
- 12. Moonstone rules are as posted and school rules are in effect.
- 13. Dress appropriately for outdoor activities in winter. A Helmet is mandatory for all participants in the school program.
- 14. Failing to follow these rules may result in immediate suspension of your skiing privileges.
