Flexible Enrolment Options

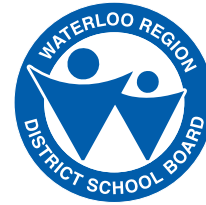

Available Programs

Extended Day Programs for Junior Kindergarten to Grade 2

The Extended Day Program is play-based and supervised by Early Childhood Educators. Based out of a fully-equipped Full Day Kindergarten classroom, children may also use other school spaces such as the gym, or library. Supports for students with special needs are available.

Youth Development Programs for Grade 3 to Grade 6

Youth Development Programs are specifically designed to engage students in Grades 3 to 6 in physical activity, social/cooperative games, drama, visual arts, and more.

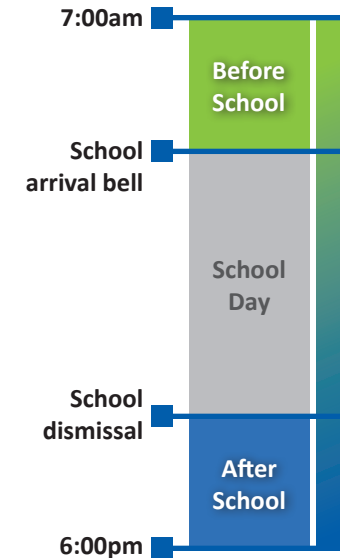
Youth Development Programs may have access to school spaces such as the gym, library, classrooms, and computer labs.

Hours of Operation

Before and After School Programs operate during the school year from 7:00am until the arrival bell and from the dismissal bell until 6:00pm. Programs are offered from 7am-6pm Monday- Friday, during staggered entry for Kindergarten in September, PD Days, and at a reduced number of sites during March break, and the non-statutory week during winter break.

Sample Schedule

- Before** • 7:00am to arrival bell
- After** • School dismissal to 6:00pm
- Both** • 7:00am to 6:00pm

Rates for board operated Extended Day programs are established annually on a cost-recovery basis.
