 very cold during the school day.
- Morning supervision begins at 8:45 am, and students should not be on the school grounds before that time.
- Please ensure that students arrive at school before the 9:00 am bell so that they can
 enter the school at their designated door, and have time to remove their coats and
 boots before class time begins
