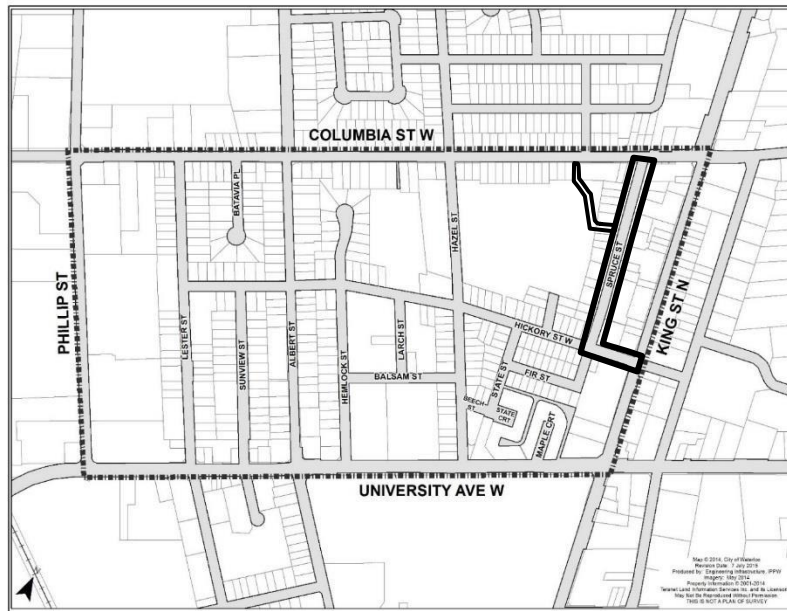




## NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

### Reconstruction of Spruce Street (Columbia St. to Hickory St.) and Hickory Street (Spruce St. to King St.)

The City of Waterloo, Engineering Services, is proceeding with the reconstruction of Spruce Street (Columbia St. to Hickory St.) and Hickory Street (Spruce St. to King St.). The work includes the replacement of sanitary sewer, storm sewer, watermain, and the complete reconstruction of the roadway including replacement of curb and gutter, and sidewalk. In addition, the project will provide a new outlet for the storm system along Waterloo Collegiate Institute lands from Columbia Street to Spruce Street. Streetscape and pedestrian lighting improvements will also be completed and a multi-use trail will be added on Hickory Street.
