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### Off Campus Student Behaviour Expectations (Cat. 2 Overnight Trip)

Participation in an Off Campus trip is an opportunity for all students to try new experiences and learn new skills in a different educational environment. All off campus locations including a camp are extensions of the classroom and the school. School and camp staff expect students to follow the same behaviour expectations that are established and reinforced at school.

#### Expectations/Understandings for Overnight Off Campus Trips:

While on the trip students are expected to comply with all expectations and policies as outlined in the Wellesley Code of Conduct, found in the Student Handbook <https://wel.wrdsb.ca/student-handbook/>

In addition, students are expected to follow the specific camp guidelines listed below while on the trip.

#### Students:

- Will respect all staff/chaperones/supervisors, other students and property.
- Will respect and follow the behaviour expectations and dress code that are established by the school.
- Will never do anything that could cause inconvenience or harm to others on the trip.
- Will be in their rooms by the established curfew times and will not be in any bedroom/cabin that has members of the opposite gender.
- Will not engage in any illegal activities including possession of any alcohol and/or illegal drugs.
- **Must not bring** any personal electronic devices (smartphones, video games, digital cameras, iPods etc.), non-prescription drugs, knives, gum, junk food or treats containing nuts.
- Will participate in all planned activities.

#### Progressive Discipline Action

If a student engages in behaviour that is contrary to the WRDSB or the school's behaviour expectations, staff may decide to consult with school administration to determine appropriate consequences and withdrawal of privileges during the trip. If the principal/vice principal feels the behaviour would lead to a suspension, the parents will be notified by the principal of the issue and suspension.

A parent/guardian may be required to pick up the student from the off campus location, send an appropriate designate for this purpose OR the student may return home with an accompanying staff member.

I have read these expectations and understand that if the school staff deems my child's behaviour unacceptable and contrary to WRDSB and Wellesley Public School Code of Conduct, then my child could be disciplined as outlined above, up to and including, being suspended and sent home. All transportation expenses for the student and any staff/chaperone will be at the cost of the parent/guardian. No refunds or price reductions will apply to reimburse parents as a result of discipline action.
