Amazon Teacher Wish Lists

- Brian/Anne looked into it. You "can" do it, but there are limited ideas to put on there; materials used by the teacher NOT the kids (e.g., professional resources, bulletin board displays etc.)
- The Ministry directive restricts us from providing other consumables
 - School Council use of funds:
 - Items not permitted would include regular program learning materials, textbooks and consumable supplies (i.e., pens, paper), classroom furniture and equipment, computer software, library books (those entering circulation) and supplies. These items must be purchased from School Operating funds.
 - Monetary payments to employees for services; Gifts to employees; Staff professional development, travel, meal and hospitality; Investments other than those permitted by the WRDSB and Regulation 471/97 of the Education Act (eligible investments); Capital infrastructure improvements and maintenance or upgrades; Support for political activities, groups or candidates.
 - Items permitted (not limited to): supplementing costs of field trips and extracurricular opportunities, guest speakers/assemblies, additional books not entering library circulation such as home reading books and other reading program books, year-end celebrations, playground improvements, subscription services such as Razkids

International Pronoun Day

- Rosanne has noticed that there are several emails from the board weekly about "days" she is feeling ill equipped to discuss these days of significance with her own children
- How can this be managed?
- Many messages get 'pushed' to the WPS website by the Board
- If it is Wellesley specific a message will come through School Day
- The "Safe Caring and Inclusive Schools" committee is talking through how, as a school
 community, we can be acknowledging these days while also taking into account cultural
 norms (e.g., in Wellesley our mennonite population can't wear orange shirt days) One
 idea they have is to have ribbon available in a variety of colours to support these days
