Playground Planning Update

- Facilities manager came out and looked at things with Brian
- What they (School Board) are doing now is asking schools "How much money do you have?". Based on this answer, they put out requests for bids based on the amount of money available to be spent
- One thing that could be done is that part of it could be removed and replaced!
- All playgrounds now that are built HAVE to be accessible; we could promote it as an
 accessible addition to what we have it would be designed in a way that would be
 multi-functional; this would bring more purpose and would be a positive thing for our
 community
- In order to this we would have to also change the surface, remove some of the outside barrier to allow access
- To do this option we would be looking at a minimum of \$40,000 \$50,000
- We will look at a committee to focus on this in the fall as part of a multi-year project
