Waterloo Forest Festival

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your son's/daughter's class will be attending a class trip to the Waterloo Region Museum on Wednesday, October 8. We will be leaving the school at 9:05am and will be returning by 2:30pm. The trip is part of a two-day event, which teaches students several key messages: the importance of the Forest Life Zone, forest ecosystems, species at risk, stewardship and conservation and climate change through hands-on interactive activities. Cost:
