- 3. GPSS I.B. is only accepting 60 students for the 2015-2016 school year. You will receive your acceptances via *mail or by phone* by *February 6th, 2015*.
- Applications <u>MUST BE</u> handed to Mrs. Serviss. GPSS is not accepting any applications directly from students or parents.

5. I.B. Course Selection Form:

- a. You must have your English, math, science, history, geography, and French teacher circle their applied or academic recommendation on the right hand side of your course selection form before taking it home to be completed by you and your family.
- b. You must choose 5 electives and number them from 1-5; 1 being the elective you're most interested in. The course selection form indicates to pick only 3 electives but please disregard that and choose 5. GPSS highly recommends taking at least one art and one physical education in grade 9 to ensure you complete your diploma requirements.
- 6. **Teacher commentary forms** must be handed to the teacher of your choice <u>BEFORE</u> Christmas break so that they have ample time to complete it.
