



Summer School 2015

To: Parents/Guardians of Grade 8 Students

The Waterloo Region District School Board plans to offer Grade 8 students an opportunity to enroll in summer school programs. This year, Grade 8 students may register for one of the following programs that best supports their learning needs and background knowledge. The High School Preparatory Program is intended for students who need support in the areas of literacy or numeracy. The Reach Ahead Program is available to students who have primarily selected applied-type courses in September 2015. These programs aim to improve student achievement by assisting students to consolidate knowledge and skills in their chosen area of focus.

Grade 8 High School Preparatory Program, Locations, and Schedules

This program is for students entering into Grade 9 in September 2015, who have achieved a level one or two on their most recent report card. These students would benefit from an interactive half-day learning experience with their peers. Students will choose either a literacy or numeracy focused class.
