- Welcome and introductions Chair
- Land Acknowledgement Principal
  - Elder Nina will be visiting Indigenous Studies Class at WODSS this week; special funding for future Indigenous studies class at WODSS and Crow Shield Lodge
- Report from the Chair
  - Great turnout at PRO Grant-funded Spring Open House; 800+ students and parents/families attended; 85+ WODSS staff attended; open house opportunity for families who had not been to WODSS during the pandemic; five Optimist Clubs (approximately 15 volunteers) participated by generously prepared food; Kyle is preparing the PRO Grant Final Report
  - This year parent council will not be bringing in baked goods for staff as a thankyou as some people are may not be comfortable sharing food among people due to COVID; will consider in the future
- WRAPSC (Waterloo Region Assembly of Public School Councils)
  - Valuable to hear about how other schools with WRAPSC facilitate their PRO Grant-funded events

- Appointment of New Chair
  - No names put forward at this time; Kyle will not have kids at WO in 2022-23, but he has offered to provide support to next year's parent council chair
  - Focus on council member recruitment in the fall

## Principal's Report

- WODSS return to normal, perhaps more fully than other schools
- Facility Updates:
  - Only one contractor bid on summer work and need minimum of three, so Family Studies cannot happen at this time; will continue with some asbestos abatement, washroom bathrooms, renovating tech receiving area into construction class space; making space for more manufacturing; have hired another tech teacher

#### Events:

- Open House for the Community
- Semi Formal at Maxwell's in Waterloo with 540 kids and staff to supervise
- Music Events: Free Concert at Kirkpatrick Park with 250 people; Outdoor concert at Nithview Seniors' Home; Spring Performances
- Relay for Life Fundraiser raised \$110,000; no challenges
- Music Awards and Athletic Awards
- Boys Slow-Pitch and Girls Slow-Pitch Finals; students moving on to Track and Field Finals
- WODSS's first Pride Assembly with WRDSB Director of Ed, jeewan chanika and Human Rights Dept attending; GSA end-of-year party
- Last day in class is June 21 followed by three instructional days
- Teacher Recognition: Staff have stepped forward to support students, even though they are tried; Carolyn shared an encouraging email from Julie Parker about WODSS's celebration of Pride Month
