# UNIVERSITY DEGREE PROGRAMS

## What type of undergraduate program is right for you?

- Bachelor Degree | 3-4 years
  - Honours Bachelor Degree | 4 years
  - Honours Bachelor Degree with Co-op | 4+ years
- Most options will require applicants to have **SIX 4U/4M** courses *including* **ENG4U**
- Required vs. recommended courses

- Complete your research through *Find a Program*
  - You can also use the *Compare* option
- Check all the information tabs carefully:
  - **Overview**
    - Enrollment, degree granted, grade range
  - **Requirements**
    - Required vs. recommended courses
  - **Admission**
    - Repeated courses, alternate offers

# STUDENTS WITH IEP's and ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES

- Most universities require a recent Psych. Ed. Assessment (within 1 - 2 years)

# TIMELINE FOR APPLICATIONS

Research degree programs and verify requirements

Deadline to submit applications through OUAC. Apply earlier if possible.

Latest date to receive an offer through OUAC

**PRIOR TO JANUARY 15**

**JANUARY 15**

**MAY 29**

**JUNE 3**

Start and modify application through OUAC

Earliest date a University may require a response to an offer of admission, tuition deposit, and deposit for residence

# MARK REPORTING TIMELINES

Marks are submitted to OCAS and OUAC throughout the school year at the following times:

**NOVEMBER**

**FEBRUARY**

**APRIL**

**JULY**

Colleges and Universities can access all of your grade 11 & 12 final marks as well as those you are taking this year.

# APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Cost is \$156 for 3 programs
  - You may apply for additional programs at a cost of \$50 per additional choice
  - Some programs are also charging additional supplemental application fees
- January 15th
  - Deadline to submit online through OUAC for equal consideration
  - Add and delete programs until this date
- If there are financial concerns with the application fees, please reach out to your guidance counsellor
- Application Workshops: October 25th and 27th in the Library Seminar Room



If you are applying to a program outside of Ontario or to a private college or university, you may need to request transcripts from Guidance. These application deadlines may be different. Check each university's website for information regarding their application process and deadline.

- Click on **Apply Now** button
- Click on **Create my Account** [yellow button]
- Start creating your OUAC profile
  - Use your legal name
  - Use a personal email address
  - Your email must be verified to complete the application process
- Create a Username & Password
  - 7-30 characters; including a number, symbol, and an upper-case letter
- Acknowledge you have Read the Terms and Conditions then **Create My Account**

- Review your choices carefully
- Review the Applicant's Declaration
