

## BACK-TO-SCHOOL KIT INFORMATION SEPTEMBER 2014

## Dear Parents/Guardians,

As one school year ends, we also begin to think about the beginning of the next. Often parents ask us for suggestions when purchasing back-to-school supplies for students. The staff members of Woodland Park have outlined purchase suggestions for you by division or program areas. Orders have been placed for grade 1-8 students for a commercially-produced planner. Students in grades 1-8 are expected to use these planners, which have been personalized for our Woodland Park students **at** a cost of \$7.00 each. Parents, please remember that the purchase of these materials is optional and basic supplies will continue to be provided by the school, however, any assistance is greatly appreciated.

\*Students in grades 6, 7 and 8 have the privilege of using lockers for their belongings. It is expected that locks will be purchased from the school (at a cost of \$5) for securing individual lockers. We have had a number of problems with the variety of locks this year that has resulted in damage to bolt cutters, lockers, etc. As a result, it is expected that only locks purchased from the school will be permitted.
