Dear Grade 8 Parents/Guardians:

Although it does seem rather early, the transition process for our grade 8 students has begun.

The first event will take place on **Wednesday, November 25th**. Our Grade 8 students will travel to Jacob Hespeler Secondary School for a tour of the school as well as an orientation of the Grade 9 program. Students will be transported by bus from Woodland Park at 8:50 a.m. and will return by 11:00 a.m.

This program includes all Grade 8 students, to will help establish a positive momentum that will lead into their Grade 9 year. As part of our Student Success initiative, it is expected that all grade 8 students will participate - alternative programming will not be provided.

On **Wednesday December 2<sup>nd</sup>**, Jacob Hespeler will be hosting a Parents Information Night at 7:00 p.m. in their cafetorium. The purpose of this evening is to inform parents about the transition to secondary school process and to address parents' questions and concerns. A tour of the facility for both students and parents will follow the presentation.

On **Thursday January 7<sup>th</sup>**, Woodland Park will be hosting a Parents Information Night at 7:00 p.m. in the gymnasium. This session will further detail the student transition process from grade 8 to 9. To limit the number of nights out of the house, we will also hold our Camp Information meeting on this evening.

The Waterloo Region District School Board has several specialized high school programs available. These programs are called Magnet Programs and are offered at several schools throughout our Region.
