### **Update on Fall Activities and Fundraisers**

Family Movie Night on Dec. 17 was a big hit showing "The Lego Movie" in the gym. Council provided popcorn to everyone and some arts and craft activities.

**QSP Magazine Fundraiser** raised approximately \$600 and the proceeds from this fundraiser, went to renewing 17 library magazine subscriptions; purchasing library bags to help students protect library books, and paying for Blue Spruce (primary) and Silver Birch (junior) books.

Simply Delicious Fundraiser raised \$1763 and the money is being used to help ensure all classes at Westvale are equipped with COWs (Computer on Wheels) which include a laptop, data projector, document camera, and set of speakers on a cart. Proceeds from 2013-14 fundraising initiatives (in the amount of \$5,700) have also been invested in this technology.

### The Home Math Kit Program

for grades 1-3 is continuing. Participation forms can be found on School Day under School Files: "Math Kit Parent Letter." Activities are fun and engaging. The kits go out Fridays and are returned Mondays. If you have any free time, we could really use more volunteers - especially on Wednesdays to check if any late kits have come in and put them away.

Subsidizing School Trips helps out all the students at Westvale. Council is providing \$150 (the average cost of a school bus for one field trip) to each class.

Recess Equipment is being replenished thanks to Council's commitment of \$500 to replace equipment that has been lost or damaged. This will include purchasing soccer balls, footballs and basketballs, skipping ropes and sidewalk chalk.

## **Gym Mats Back in Shape**

Our gym mats are back in tiptop shape. Earlier this year it came to Council's attention that the Velcro strips holding the mats on the gym walls were worn out on 11 mats. Rather than sending them to landfill and replacing them at a high cost, Council found an Old Order Mennonite couple in Milverton, Mr. & Mrs. Era S. Streicher, to help. The Streicher's have a small business on their farm making and repairing harnesses.

Three Westvale moms and one Westvale grandma spent approximately eight hours ripping apart the Velcro stitching to prepare the mats. (Thanks ladies!!) The Steicher's then replaced all the velcro and sewed the mats back together again. They could only work in daylight hours as they do not have electrical lighting in their shop; but they got the job done in less than a week. They said "we enjoyed doing it--it was a different kind of project...and we know it's going to a good cause!" They even took the time to pull out years worth of collected threads in the "hook" part of the velcro.

We really appreciated the Streicher's creative use of their skills, their willingness to find a way we could do part of the labour with volunteers, and for giving us a discount.
