Student Drop-Off and Parking

It's interesting that research reported on CBC Radio this week reveals that the most dangerous adult driving behaviour is in the morning on their way to work, and of course that coincides with when children are most exposed to this risk. Child safety has to be all of our biggest concern. Let's pull, together, get our best patience going in the morning, come early, and take our turn in the parking line-up on the street.

Also, now that our littlest TRAILBLAZERS have made a smooth transition to school, a gentle reminder that parents must wave good bye to their children outside. I know you understand that adult entry must be controlled as part of our Safe Welcome Program. If you need to have a word with a teacher or with administration, please come in through the front door and inquire at the office. Thank-you!

New Health Curriculum and Faith and Religious Accommodations
