School Administrative Report

- Around the School
 - Check the school calendar for exact dates of upcoming events Shower Cap Day, Cake Walk Day, Jump Rope for Heart, Arts Night, EQAO, Track and Field Day (School and Regional) Humane Society visits, Freezie Fridays
 - Ministry of Women's Equity and Development attended school because of a letter a grade 6 student sent to her about inequality in sports. Fantastic visit.
 Empowered the kids telling them they are able to make changes.
 - New ESL teacher, increase in time as well
 - Tomorrow is student wellness day including guided meditation, yoga, drumming, reading story, bucket wall, giving back centre, sensory station, mindful colouring.
 A mix of different grades at each station.
 - Older kids from the CBC choir sang the song at the board annual general meeting. It was very moving. The Harlem Globetrotters heard about the choir and asked them to sing O'Canada at the start of the game in April.
 - A lot of clubs happen at WTT. It is usually announced and kids are asked to come and get a form and first forms back get in the club. Setting up a school day account that will notify parents if their kids are in the club and is an ability to send out any communications.
